## **ACADEMIC PROGRAM**

Admission to the Academy is competitive and students are evaluated based upon five areas: application with essay; letters of recommendation; transcript; entrance exam; and interview. Our Lady of Mercy Academy offers college prep, honors and AP courses, Dual credit is also available through various community colleges.

Students take seven academic courses per year including:

Theology: 4 years English: 4 years Mathematics: 4 years History: 3 years

Science (with lab): 3 years Foreign Language: 2 years

L2T -- Leadership, Life Skills & Technology. L2T includes Bravery Forward, Lifetime Fitness, and Public Speaking in Grade 9, followed by STEM and Business 101, Digital Literacy, Financial Literacy, and Introduction to Computer Science in Grade 10.

Mini-Mester Courses: The OLMA Mini-Mester is a weeklong experiential learning course that can include academic research, travel, service or leadership training. Students receive academic credit.

OLMA is accredited by Middle States Association of Secondary Schools & Colleges and is a member of the National Catholic Education Association, the National Coalition for Girls' Schools, and the New Jersey Association of Independent Schools.
